We began fielded an online quantitative poll between December 6 and December 22, 2016. This data has been weighted to represent Trump voters based on the exit polls in each of the six states poll. This report based on a total of 3,000 Midwestern Trump voters to test support for American ethanol.


We polled Trump voters in the Upper Midwest – the key political group that carried him to victory – about their views on ethanol and their hopes for ethanol’s roll in the nation’s energy future. The results are crystal clear: **Trump voters in the Midwest think ethanol plays an important role on America’s energy security.**

Overwhelmingly, supporters of President-Elect Trump think ethanol is important to America’s energy independence and economy, and it should be a part of our energy mix. In all, 83% of these supporters agree with the President-Elect’s campaign promise to continue the ethanol blend in gasoline.






- 96% of Trump supporters in these states believe American-made energy sources should be used to reduce dependence on foreign hostile nations




- Trump voters overwhelmingly think using biofuels like ethanol is important to increase energy security and support American jobs.




- Trump voters overwhelmingly believe ethanol should be part of the energy mix to reduce dependence on foreign oil and create jobs.
